

# What to expect when visiting our offices

In order to protect our patients, staff and providers, we have put protocols in place to minimize in-office foot traffic and promote social distancing. Please be aware and prepared when you visit.



When visiting our office, always wear a face mask. Please ensure it covers your nose and mouth.



Reference COVID signage on office doors. Do not enter the office if you are experiencing COVID symptoms.



Patients will continue to be COVID screened using our electronic pre-registration process.



After check-in, you'll be able to stay in our waiting room only if social distancing is possible. Otherwise, patients may return to their cars and be notified when a patient room is available.



If you return to your car, bring water to stay hydrated while you wait, especially since outside temperatures are rising.



We are now allowing one person to accompany the patient to the patient room, such as a caregiver or family member. We ask that this be limited to patients who need extra assistance.



Please do not come to our office if you're COVID positive, you've been tested and are waiting on results, or you've been exposed to someone with COVID.
