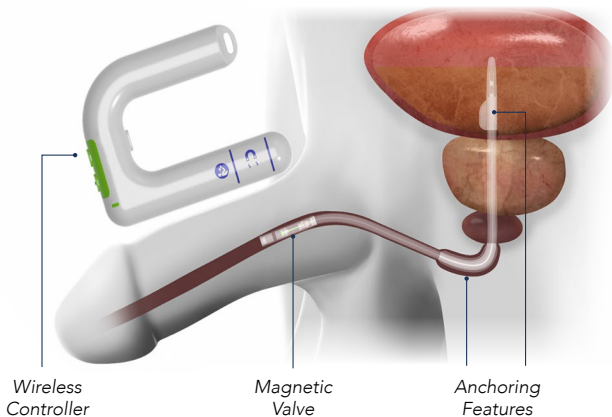

# The FREEDOM Study

This study is designed to evaluate the safety and performance of the Connected Catheter System in men with chronic Urinary Retention.

You may be able to participate in the study.



## What is the Connected Catheter?

- Fully internal to the male anatomy
- Extended use (up to 7 days)
- Designed to reduce multiple daily catheter insertions
- Designed to be quickly removed or inserted by user, caregiver or clinician

## STUDY STEPS - 6 APPOINTMENTS

- 1 PRESCREENING PERIOD**  
Phone screening, 15-20 minutes  
Initial assessment to decide if the study is right for you
- 2 CLINIC ASSESSMENT**  
2-3 hour office visit
- 3 INITIAL DEVICE INSERTION**  
5-6 hour office visit where the Connected Catheter will be placed.
- 4 CATHETER TRIAL PERIOD**  
Weekly office visits, 1-1.5 hours each. You have 4 device cycles  
*A Cycle is:*
  - catheter insertion
  - up to 7 days of catheter use
  - catheter removal
- 5 FOLLOW-UP PERIOD**  
2 surveys, via phone call  
15-20 minutes each
